1 – Cut Your Job Search Time in Half.

According to the US Bureau of Labor Statistics, the average time to find a job is 189 or more days, yet 3.9 million positions are currently unfilled in the US. How is it recruiters complain they can't find qualified candidates, unemployment remains well over 7%, and talented, valuable contributors continue to be unemployed?

Without realizing it, most job seekers are exacerbating the problem by repeating unproductive behaviors that delay employment: wasting hours combing job boards and fruitless networking activities, underselling themselves on their resume and performing poorly during interviews. They ignore the hidden job market where 85% of all jobs are found, for the easily accessible, intensely competitive, advertised job market that lists only 15% of available jobs.
